

# BRC PROGRESS UPDATE

## WEEK 10

### Progress since the last update:

- We completed the demolition of the single storey A building. The picture below shows the final pieces of building rubble and waste being moved :



- The breaking up of the slab foundation under the old A building extension continued last week.
- New partition walls were installed in A building 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floors.
- The first fix of power, data and plumbing in A building continued on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floors.
- 100m<sup>3</sup> of concrete was poured for the foundations for the East end of the New Building. The pictures on the right show that work in progress.
- 200 tonnes of stone was delivered to site to lay the base of the new car parking areas to the East and North of D building.
- The fencing around the new energy centre has been moved to allow 2 way traffic to operate around the site.

## Key Activities This Week:

- plastering of the new partition walls in A building on the 1<sup>st</sup>, 2<sup>nd</sup> and 3<sup>rd</sup> floors.
- final demolition of the ground floor slab of the old A building extension.
- 30m<sup>3</sup> of additional concrete to be poured into the foundations of the new building.
- First fix of floor trenches and rises along the old engineering corridor and up into A building.
- We will plan the sequence of cladding works to D building later this week.
- Wind-posts should be installed on the energy centre base followed by the commencement of block work to create the walls.

## Parking Permits:

We have had over 100 requests for parking permits from staff so far. The new parking policy comes into effect from 1 October. If you intend to park on site from this date please ensure that you have completed a parking request form – see HR for further details.

## Messages for Students:

We still have some cycles parked against the railings where they are at risk of theft.
