Discretionary Learner Support & Advanced Learner Loan Bursary Fund for Students Information for Students Aged 19 and Over

The **Discretionary Learner Support Fund and Advanced Learner Loans Bursary Fund are** designed to support students who have genuine financial hardship towards the additional costs involved in attending College. You can apply to these funds for help towards the cost of essential kits, uniforms, course materials and equipment, personal protective equipment (PPE), trips that are essential for your course, college bus passes and/or the cost of travelling to college by train and registered childcare if you are aged 20 or over at the start of your course. The Fund is 'cash-limited' which means that we cannot always support every student that applies; we only allocate awards while funding lasts.

Are you eligible?

To apply to this fund, you must be:

- Aged 19 or over at the start of your course (on or before 1st September 2020)
- Studying a 'funded', Further Education course (students studying Apprenticeships, HE courses, or 'full cost courses' are **not** eligible)
- UK resident or meet sufficient residency criteria
- Living in a household where the income level is below £25,000 per year

How to apply

- 1. Check that you meet all of the criteria listed above
- Attach evidence of household income as listed on the form please note that photocopied evidence IS acceptable, as are scanned or photographed documents sent via email. ORIGINAL DOCUMENTS SENT THROUGH THE POST WILL NOT BE RETURNED WITHOUT A STAMPED ADDRESSED ENVELOPE
- 3. If you have applied for an Advanced Learner Loan you will need to supply evidence of your entitlement to the loan with this application form.
- 4. Send the application form and evidence to the address below (please ensure that you add enough postage if sending through the post)

What happens next?

We will aim to process your application within two weeks from the date we receive it. If you have not completed the form in full or you have not provided evidence of your household income then we will return the form to you. When we have assessed your application we will write to you with the outcome explaining how your award will be paid. If your application is unsuccessful we will send you a letter explaining why which will include details of **how you can appeal**.

*Important Information – Course Fees+

Please note that you <u>cannot</u> apply to this fund for help with your course **fees** (tuition and exam/registration fees). Please contact the Enrolments Team on 01329 815170 if you would like information about whether you qualify for **fee remission** for your course. Eligibility can depend on a number of factors including:

- Your age when you start the course
- The level of qualification you are planning to study and any qualifications that you have already achieved
- Whether or not you are in receipt of certain 'out of work' benefits
- What you are planning to do when you have completed your course

Please be prepared to answer questions of this nature if you are asking about fee remission. If you are not eligible for **fee remission** then you will be responsible for paying your course fees in full
