- Study Maths and English if not already achieved.

Entry requirements:

In order to complete this programme you will need to be aged between 19-24* years old.

Duration:

The duration of this Traineeship programme is 10 weeks.


What will this programme cover?

Training: Weeks 1-6

- / Initial assessment

- / Employability awareness
- CSCS Trainee Card leading to a Green Card on successful completion of the traineeship.
- / Functional skills (if required).

Work Experience: Weeks 6-10

Four weeks work experience placement (amounting to 70-140 hours).
